The Composite includes all discretionary accounts with market values greater than \$5 million managed by Loomis Sayles with the objective of maximizing total return through individual security selection with a 15% limit in high yield securities and use of out-of-benchmark sectors including but not limited to non-US dollar denominated, emerging market debt, convertibles, securitized debt and bank loans. Yield curve and duration management provide additional tactical tools for the portfolio management team with strategic allocation to higher yielding credit sensitive sectors employing Loomis Sayles security level research and significant allocation to non-index sectors serimary sources of alpha. Tracking error is not explicitly targeted for this product, however, historically these portfolios have exhibited annualized tracking error of approximately 200-500 basis points. As of 1/1/2021 the Composite was redefined to include commingled vehicles, previously only separate accounts were included. The Composite inception date is January 1, 1989.
