### TRANSFORMING THE SAINT PATRICK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

On June 2nd, 2010, Loomis Sayles champions gathered for a powerful day of service at the Saint Patrick Elementary School. In just four hours, 39 dedicated volunteers transformed the school grounds into a more vibrant and inviting space through painting playground games and a basketball court on the school blacktop and creating bright panel murals that will be hung both inside the school and in the outdoor play space. Additionally, courageous volunteers landscaped and weeded all of the outdoor green space that surrounds the school.
